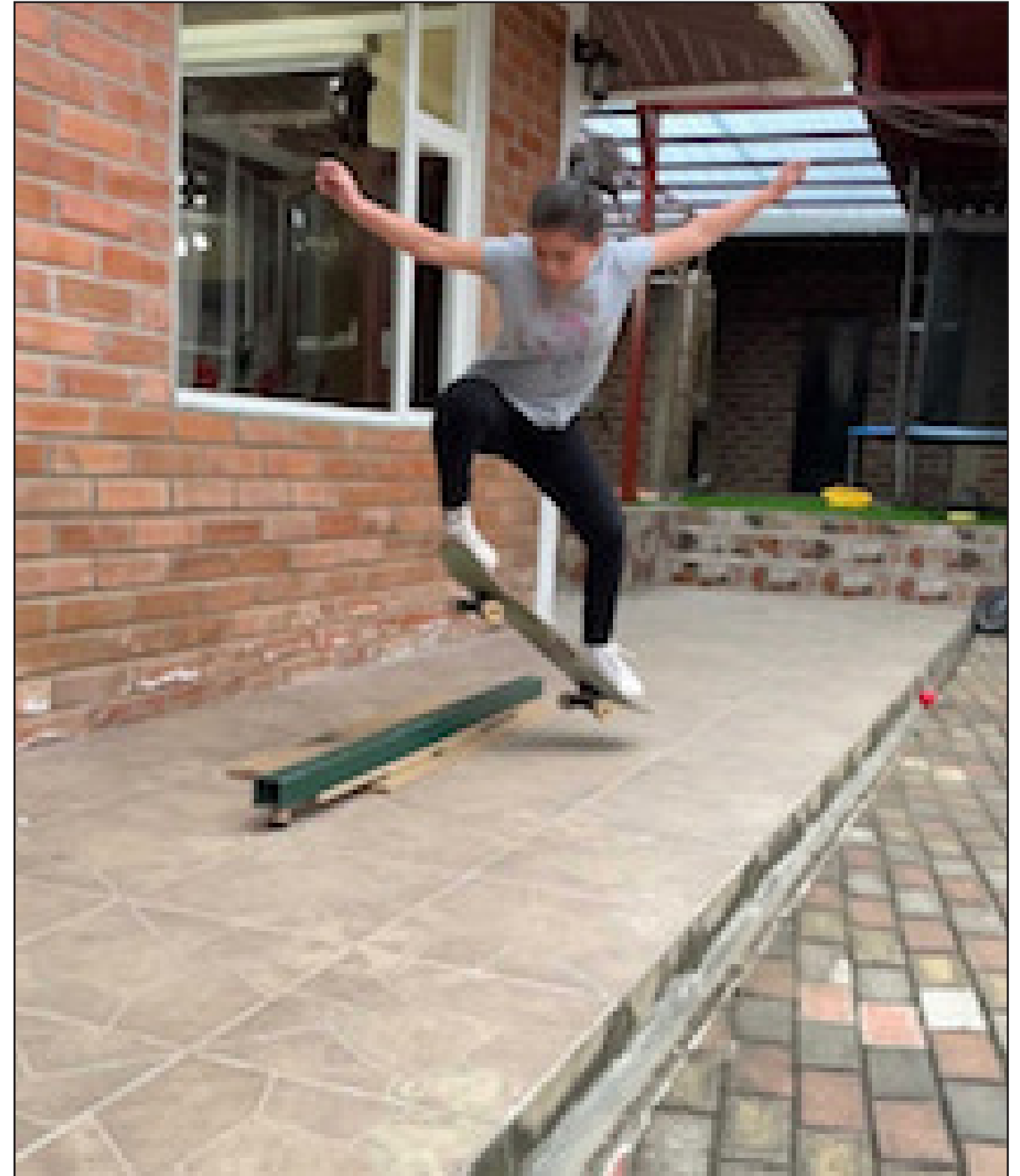
**MY DREAMS, GOALS, CHALLENGES AND ACHIEVEMENTS**

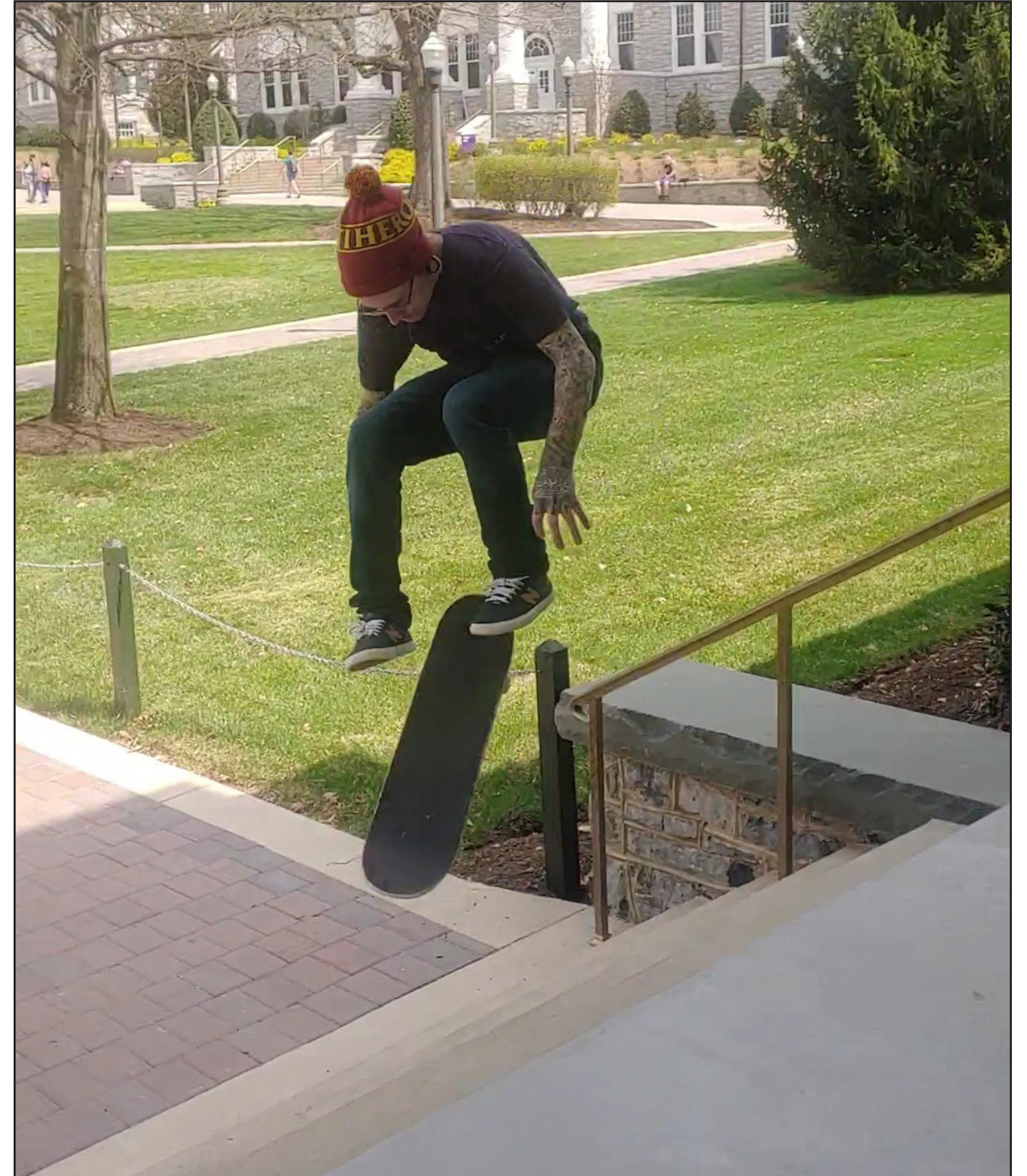




### Skaker

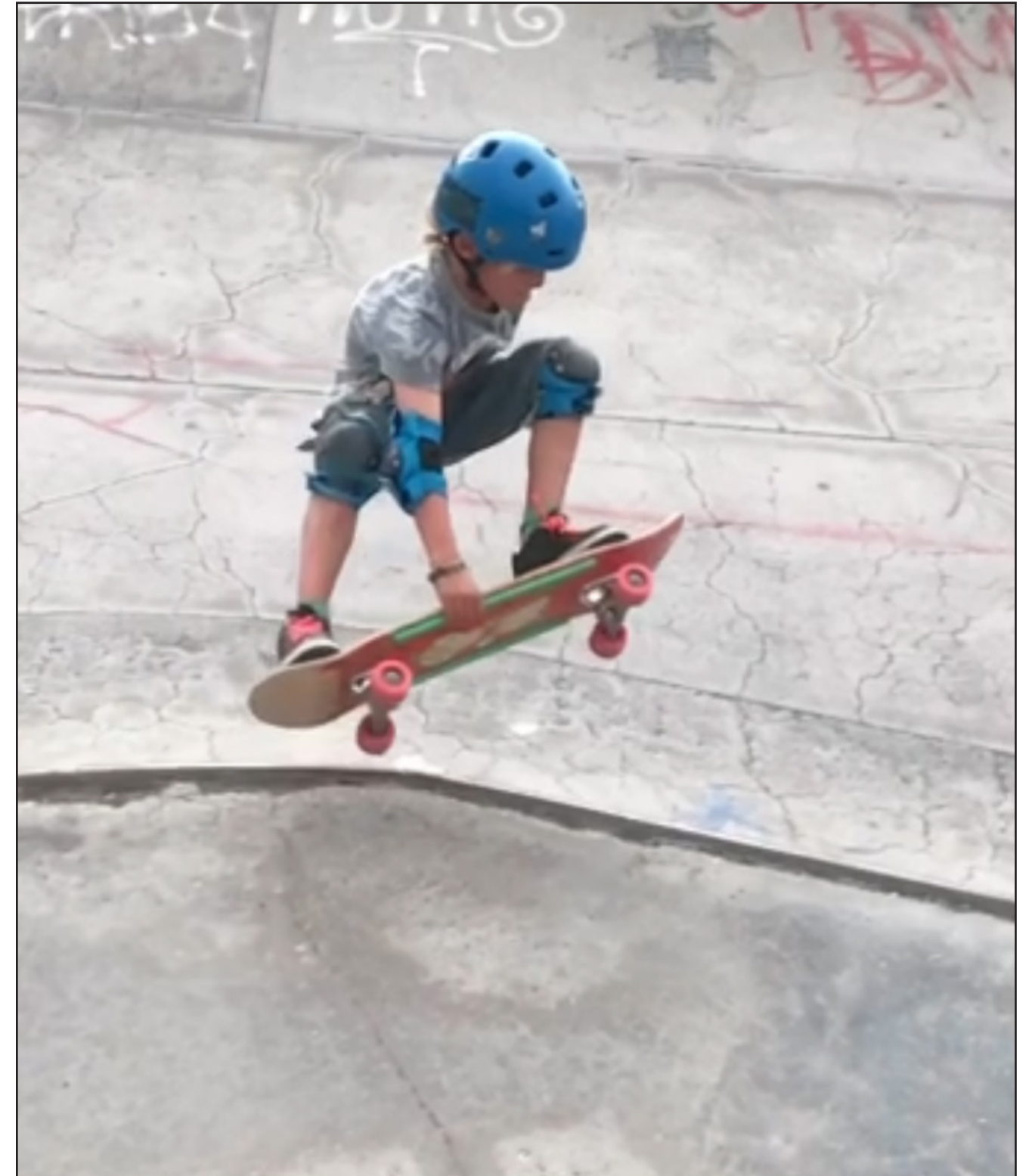

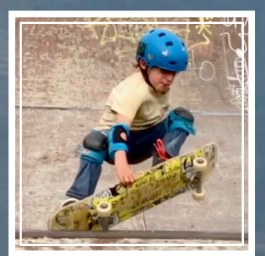
*This year I bought a new setup and hit the park and found what was missing.*

*I don't see retirement in my future infact, I'm working on a few new unique tricks to put in our next film.*

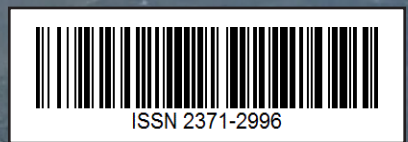
